### Instructions for Completing the Course Request Form

In this presentation will we go over how to complete the Course Request Form, including required core academic courses and selection of electives courses.

Students must enroll in four core classes, and three electives. Howard Middle School provides students with a rigorous academic program. Elective courses are based on student interest and seat availability.

### First Part of the Course Request Form

- This form is to be filled out by the student AND a parent/guardian
- Students Name:
  - Please fill out your name as it appears on Skyward if you are a current OCPS student. If you are new to OCPS your name should match the name on the OCPS registration forms.
- Check the boxes for 504, IEP, or Gifted by selecting "Yes" because it applies to you, "No" because it doesn't apply to you, or "Unsure".
- PE
  - Select "Yes" if you are planning on taking PE next year
  - If you are NOT planning on taking PE, you will need to fill out a PE

#### **Elective Course Selections**

- 1. You will be scheduled for **3 elective classes**, however we ask you to **rank order your top 7 choices**, with #1 being your first choice, #2 is your second choice and so on.
- 2. Depending on requests and teachers availability, it is possible that some electives will not be offered next year. If this happens, we will select your next choice.
- 3. Some electives have a prerequisite which means you must take a lower level class before you can take that class.
  - e.g. you must take Theater 1 before you can take Musical Theater 1
