

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Congratulations on this educational milestone for your student. Transitioning to a new school is exciting and should be smooth and without any delays. In an effort to ensure all student's records are accurate and up to date, we are requiring parents to provide updated current proof of residence to your child's present school. This documentation should be provided to the school by close of business on April 15, 2024.

Failure to provide updated verification of residence will result in your child's withdrawal from OCPS and you risk your student not having a schedule for the start of the 2024 school year.

To verify your address you must provide the following:

- If you own a house: warranty deed, property taxes, closing contract, or homestead exemption card along with current utility bill, your ID with current address, and current mail.
- If you rent a house or apartment: provide the signed lease, your ID with your current address, recent utility bill, proof of rent payments, current mail, and renters insurance.
- If you live with someone who owns or rents the house: you must obtain a Verification of Residence from Student Enrollment Office. You will need to provide a minimum of the following documents:
- Your ID with current address
 Three items with your name and address dated within the last month, such as car registration, paystub, bank statement, insurance, phone bill, or current mail.
- 3. In addition, you must provide the ID of the lessee or homeowner and a copy of the lease or proof of homeownership.

More documentation may be required depending on circumstances in a case-by-case situation.

The School Board of Orange County, Florida ("Board") shall establish residential attendance zones for each school. All students, unless otherwise provided by the Board, shall attend the school serving such student's residential attendance zone. For purposes of this policy, a student's residence is defined as the residence/domicile of the parent(s), legal guardian(s), legal custodian(s), or other such person as defined as a legal guardian of the student by any order issued by a court of competent jurisdiction of the State of Florida (collectively, "Guardian"). Any student residing in the Orange County Public Schools ("OCPS") district shall be assigned to a school for attendance by the Superintendent or designee.

TDAP Vaccine Clinic at Howard Middle, March 8, 2024

Parents of rising seventh grade students:

The state of Florida requires students to have all of their required immunizations before a child enters 7th grade. This is a friendly reminder that if you have an eleven year-old they are eligible for the Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis immunization also known as Tdap. This is a required shot before entering 7th grade. We will be offering a TDAP vaccine clinic at our school on March 8, 2024.





Things students need to play sports during the 2023-24 school year:

Athletics procedures have changed this year when it comes to sports physicals, as <u>parents/legal guardians</u> <u>must now register students in the Aktivate Portal</u>.

Instructions for creating an account and registering students for the sports activity is below:

CREATE A PARENT/GUARDIAN ACCOUNT:

- □ On <u>www.aktivate.com</u>, click Login
- □ Click Create an Account

* <u>You only need ONE account</u>, even if you have children in more than one high school and/or junior high

* Do not create another account if you have used Register My Athlete/Aktivate in the past

□ Fill in your personal account information. You will be using the site as a Parent/Guardian.

Click Create Account

□ Shortly after creating your account, you will receive an **email with a 6-digit Verification Code**. Use this code to verify your account when prompted.

* **Do not close your current tab**. You will need to open your email in another tab and find the verification email in your email inbox (it may take a few minutes to appear, so be patient).

REGISTER YOUR STUDENT FOR AN ACTIVITY:

- Login with your email address and password
- Under the Parents header, click the button labeled Click here to start/complete athlete registrations
- Click Start/Complete Registrations under "What would you like to do?"
- Click the New Registration + button in the upper right hand corner
- Start by clicking the red Select School bar and follow the directions as they appear
- Continue following the steps presented in the red bars
- □ Once your registration is complete, you'll receive a confirmation email from us

- a. For soccer and volleyball, students last year's semester GPA MUST be a 2.0

OCPS Student Dress Code

The dress and grooming of OCPS students shall contribute to the health and safety of the individual, promote a positive educational environment, and not disrupt the educational activities and processes of the school. These standards of dress and grooming apply to all students in the public schools of Orange County.

- Clothes shall be worn as they are designed.

- Clothing must cover the body from one armpit across to the other armpit and down to approximately mid-thigh. Tops must have straps. Undergarments must not be viewable. Rips, holes, or tears in clothing must be below mid-thigh.

- Shoes shall be worn at all times and should be safe for the school environment.

- Headgear shall not be worn on campus during the school day, unless the headgear is approved by the principal.

- See-through, revealing, or mesh garments must not be worn without appropriate coverage underneath that meet the minimum requirements of this dress code.

- Gang paraphernalia, garments and/or jewelry, tattoos, or other insignias, which display or suggest sexual, vulgar, drug, alcohol, or tobacco related wording/graphics or may tend to provoke violence or disruption in school, shall not be worn.

- Clothing must not state, imply, or depict hate speech or imagery targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation, or any other protected class.

Any student who violates this dress policy will be subject to disciplinary action as outlined in Sections IV and V of the Code, Section 1006.07(2)(d), Florida Statutes, and below:

1. For a first offense, a student shall be given a verbal warning and the school may call the student's parent/guardian.

2. For the second offense, a student is ineligible to participate in any extracurricular activity for a period of time not to exceed 5 days and the school may meet with the student's parent/guardian.

3. For a third or subsequent offense, a student shall receive an in-school suspension pursuant to Section 1003.01(5), Florida Statutes, for a period not to exceed 3 days, the student is ineligible to participate in any extracurricular activity for a period not to exceed 30 days, and the school may call the student's parent/guardian.



OCPS Cell Phone Policy for Students

A student may possess a cell phone on Board property, on school transportation and at school activities, provided that during school hours, the cell phone is silenced and concealed. Pursuant to Section 1006.07, Florida Statutes, "a student may not use a wireless

communications device during instructional time, except when expressly directed by a teacher solely for educational purposes. **A teacher shall designate an area for wireless**

communications devices during instructional time." For purposes of this section, the designated area will be in the student's backpack or purse, except when expressly directed by a teacher solely for educational purposes. Violations of the cell phone policy will be handled in accordance with the Code and may result in confiscation of said device. If the cell phone is used in a criminal act (such as sexting as outlined in Florida Statutes and the Code), the cell phone will be provided to law enforcement and the student may face criminal penalties.

The use of wireless communication devices is always prohibited during the school day (from the first morning bell to dismissal) unless expressly directed by a teacher solely for educational purposes. Wireless communication devices include but are not limited to, cell

phones and/or auxiliary/ancillary devices such as watches and ear buds. Students may not receive discipline if they use their cellphone and/or ancillary device(s) to monitor a health condition that is documented through medical records provided to the school including, but not limited to, an IEP, a Section 504 Plan or a Health Plan. At no time shall OCPS be responsible for theft, loss or damage to cell phones or other electronic devices brought onto its property.


These standards apply to all students in the public schools of Orange County.

Arrival and Dismissal (Car Loop)

We use the track (across the street on Robinson) as our car loop. Cars must enter on the west side, closest to Summerlin, and then will exit on the other side. Students should arrive between 9:00am and 9:25am as there is no supervision available before 9:00 am.

Afternoons tend to be more hectic in the beginning than it will be once everyone learns the process. Please do not park at nearby residences, the local 7-Eleven or other nearby businesses, as you run the risk of being towed and trespassed by the Orlando Police. We appreciate your patience and willingness to follow our procedures for all students' safety.

After school, all students must exit through the front doors, and car riders then cross the street to the track. We ask students to wait on the field until their car has pulled up closer to the front of the line, so as to help keep traffic moving. We appreciate everyone's efforts at helping students to understand the importance of waiting for their car instead of loading in at the back of the line.
