That's the core of the Fat Girl Rules inscribed by Ellie, nicknamed Splash after a poolside cannonball in early childhood drew fatphobic teasing. As sixth grade starts, she knows it'll be hell, and she's right: the bullying her peer group habitually engages in has only gotten more vicious, and worse still, her mother is controllingly, cruelly obsessed with Ellie's weight ("Ellie, we're just trying to fix you"). In this free-verse novel, Fipps is laceratingly authentic about the kind of "teasing" and "help" that Ellie is constantly subject to, and the family dynamic, wherein her father dislikes her mother's treatment but rarely intervenes, is sadly believable. The book gains hopefulness from Ellie's experience with a gifted therapist and from her growing friendship with neighbor Catalina and her warm family. There's not much dimension to secondary characters (or even Ellie) beyond the central problem of fatphobia, but the intense focus mirrors a lot of experience, and readers will be glad to see Ellie eventually "starfishing--starting to claim my right to take up space." Reviews by: Horn Book Magazine Since she was five, Ellie (now eleven) has lived by a list of Fat Girl Rules: "Make yourself small"; "Move slowly so / your fat doesn't jiggle"; "When you hear laughter, / someone's laughing at you." She only feels comfortable in her body when she's swimming or spending time with her dog or her similarly fat best friend, Viv. But when Viv moves away, Ellie is alone in facing the sixth-grade bullies, who call her a whale, slam doors in her face, and -- horrifyingly -- loosen the screws on her desk so it collapses. It's not much better outside of school, where strangers make rude comments, or at home, where her mother posts dieting articles on the fridge and even takes her to see a bariatric surgeon without her consent. (If it all seems too cruel to be realistic, an author's note explains that these experiences are based on Fipps's own.) Luckily, Ellie has the support of her dad, a new friend, and an understanding therapist who teaches her to stand up for herself. When her best friend Viv moves away, a new friend, Catalina, fits right into her place. Ellie's dad is also an ally; he stands up to Ellie's mom and decides to take Ellie to a therapist. With the help of Dr. Wood, Ellie learns how to feel comfortable in her own skin. Once readers start, it will be difficult for them to put this book down. Twelve-year-old Cumba loves his family and home in Cuba's mountains, but Fidel Castro's ascent to power has made life chaotic and frightening. Castro's socialist agenda comes with soldiers patrolling the streets and whispers that turn neighbors against one another. Cumba himself is now old enough to be recruited for Castro's "Young Rebels," a precursor to mandatory military training, and that's not a fate the boy's parents will permit. With heavy hearts and secret contacts on the island, they obtain the forged paperwork needed to fly Cumba to the U.S. and to safety. With the threat of Cumba getting drafted into the military, his family sends him to the United States alone. He has a loving family, friends at school, and loves building models so one day he can be an architect. However, life in Santa Clara, Cuba, is far from ordinary in 1961. Fidel Castro, now in power after his successful campaign against dictator Fulgencio Batista, has defeated a group of Cuban refugees who tried to overthrow Fidel during the Bay of Pigs invasion. But as Cumba's grandfather noted "we traded one dictator for another," and life was hard in Cuba. Children were sent to Russia for military training or forced to join the Young Rebel forces. In addition, people were executed; schools' curriculum modified to disseminate communist propaganda; neighbors turned against one another; and churches were closed, with foreign priests expelled. Cumba's parents have only one choice. First-generation Cuban American author Cuevas offers a historical novel inspired by the experience of her father, who as a boy had to leave Cuba alone and start a new life in the United States. The 34-chapter work, written in English with some Spanish

terms interlaced in the narrative, is divided into two sections-one depicting Cumba's life in Cuba, and the second, starting in chapter 12, exploring his life in Florida. Of interest to educators, the text contains many English vocabulary words. However, the novel is filled with secondary characters that help to move the story forward but lack meaningful character development. What makes this novel strong is Cuevas's ability to capture the spirit of this Caribbean country, its food, flora, and fauna, and Cubans' cultural traits. 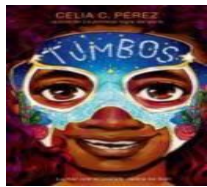

Pulled from her admittedly chaotic life with her parents, who are struggling with addiction, Laura copes with the overwhelming changes that a new caregiver, new rules, a new school, and new peers bring, while suffering with extreme feelings of guilt over making the 911 call that resulted in her parents' being placed in rehab. Spares are mistreated and looked down upon in the Twelve Towns, and Seven refuses to accept that fate, invoking the Clause of the Impossible Task: to prove their worth the girls must slay the fearsome Nightbeast. Failing the impossible task, though, means that the trio will be "toadified," so Seven has to quickly learn how to work with a new friend and an old enemy before the deadline hits. Ortega's witchy world is committed to its bubbly aesthetic and is brimming with amusingly eccentric references, such as "Real Witch Wives of Hastings-on-Pumpkins" and an amphibian named Edgar Allan Toad. 

Sadly, only Poppy joins House Hyacinth and in a nightmare come true, Seven finds out that she's a Spare. In the magical town of Ravenskill, Spares are looked down on and have less power. To make matters worse, also in her coven are Seven's bully, Valley Pepperhorn, and a girl named Thorn. When the three are unable to seal their coven, Seven invokes the impossible task which, if completed successfully, would seal their coven and give them their full power as witches. Their impossible task to fell the Nightbeast is a difficult enough endeavor, but they also have to contend with their constant bickering, the community's unfavorable view toward Spares, and a mysterious conspiracy surrounding the Nightbeast. The trio of witchlings eventually overcome misunderstandings, grow to trust each other, and work together. The sorting system has a unique spin to it with the presence and treatment of the Spares. Readers familiar with Spanish may recognize the magic words used to cast spells: viento for wind, esconder for hiding something, and so on. Among the cast are many Latinx characters, a character with a nonbinary gender identity, and those in a same-sex relationship. The poor treatment of Spares may spark a timely conversation on the lack of protection for marginalized communities. The witchlings also find out that Valley's father is abusive, on one occasion starving her for two days because of a bad grade. Mentions of abuse may be distressing to some readers. 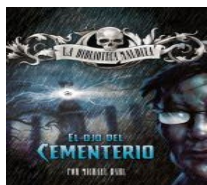
